Common Rules for Admissions to Direct Second Year of B. Pharm in the academic session 2026-27

Against CAP (ACAP) admissions for the Direct Second Year of Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm lateral entry) are conducted at the institutional level to fill seats that remain vacant or unfilled after the final Centralised Admission Process (CAP) rounds conclude.

1. Admissions are governed by the strict guidelines of the State Common Entrance Test Cell (CET Cell), Government of Maharashtra.
2. **Mandatory CET Cell Registration:** To be eligible for an Against CAP seat, the candidate must have completed online registration and successfully verified their documents through the official State CET Cell Portal during the standard CAP cycle and fulfil the eligibility criteria for admission. They must possess a valid Application ID and Merit Number.
3. **Strict Merit-Based Selection:** Admissions must be conducted transparently and filled strictly according to the Inter-Se-Merit of the candidates who apply to the college as well as CET portal for the vacant seats.
4. **Cancellation of Prior Seats:** If a candidate has already been admitted to a college during regular CAP rounds, they must officially cancel their previous admission before confirming their seat under the Against CAP round.
5. **Educational Background:** The candidate must be an Indian National and must have passed a Diploma Course in Pharmacy (D. Pharm) from an institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI).
6. **Stage-Wise Seat Allocation Procedure:** Colleges must follow a specific progression rules when allocating ACAP seats to maintain equity as below:
 - A) **Stage 1 (Category Match):** Seats are initially offered to candidates belonging to the exact same category (e.g., Minority- Hindi Linguistic) for which the seat was originally earmarked during the CAP rounds.

B) **Stage 2 (Conversion of Reserved Seats):** If candidates from the specific category (e.g., Minority- Hindi Linguistic) are unavailable, the seat is converted into a general seat and filled based on Open Category Inter-Se-Merit among the remaining applicants.

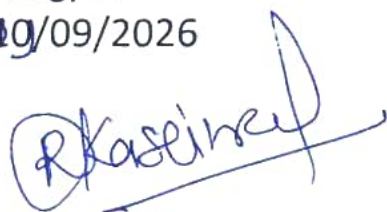
7. Fee Structures & Financial Limitations:

A) No Scholarship Benefits: Candidates admitted under Against CAP (ACAP) vacancies in private unaided institutions cannot claim government category concessions or social welfare scholarships (such as EBC or caste-based fee waivers) except SC category.

B) Full Fee Payment: Admitted candidates are required to pay the full fees of Rs. 1,34,000/- (in words Rs. One Lac Thirty-Four Thousand only) as approved by the Fee Regulating Authority (FRA). At the time of confirmation of admission student has to pay Rs. 1000/- online on CET portal.
