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
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Abstract:

He suggested running special campaigns in every college and university in the country to connect more and more youth with this campaign. The Prime Minister mentioned the launch of Ideas Portal related to Viksit Bharat and informed that suggestions can be given on 5 different themes. "A prize has also been arranged for the best 10 suggestions. You can also give your suggestions on MyGov", he added. "Idea starts with an '1' just like India begins with an '1'", the Prime Minister remarked as he underlined that the idea of development can only begin with the '1' of theself.



Drawing the analogy of the period of development of 'Viksit Bharat' to that of an examination, the Prime Minister mentioned the confidence, preparation and dedication of the students as well as the contributions of the families in maintaining the required discipline to accomplish the goal. 

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


